Lenten Message from the Pastor 4th Sunday of Lent Fr. Dwayne McNew



Dear parish family,

During my first visit to this parish as I was getting a tour, I was struck by the simplicity and beauty of the church. I have always had stain glass windows at my previous parishes, yet there is such beauty at looking out the window and seeing God's creation and seeing real deer grazing on the hillside. Then I looked above the altar and my heart stopped when my eyes met the eyes of Jesus on the Cross. His eyes are looking to the heavens still alive calling me to look at His love crucified.

Today's gospel offers a different version of the Cross. The Cross here is a pathway that can lead to belief, light, and eternal life. The Cross in the Gospel is lifted up over us. But instead of being a dark looming presence, it is a healing presence. The shadow that is cast over us is not of darkness or fear but of freedom and light. This Cross is what our journey to heaven is all about. This Lent as you stand beneath the Cross in our parish let Jesus set you free from your fears and chains. Allow His shadow of light to lift your spirit!
