DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY, APRIL 7:

Exposition of the **Blessed Sacrament** begins at **2:00 p.m.**with meditation every 15 minutes and singing of the **Divine Mercy Chaplet** at **3:00 p.m.** and closing with **Benediction** at **3:30 p.m. Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be available.

Requirements for Plenary Indulgence for **Divine Mercy Sunday**: Celebrate the **Sacrament of Reconciliation 20** days before or after **Divine Mercy Sunday**. Receive Holy Communion on **Divine Mercy Sunday**. Pray for the intentions of **Pope Francis**. (An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven.)

Divine Mercy with Fr. Michael Gaitley: Renowned speaker and author Fr.
