

THE 10TH ANNUAL MADISON COUNTY MARCH FOR LIFE will take place on Thursday, November 2! NEW THIS YEAR: The march will leave from St. Patrick Church at 61 S. Union Street, London, at 5:00 p.m., process through downtown, and convene at the courthouse by 5:30 p.m. for prayer and peaceful witness against Issue 1. WHAT IS FIRST FRIDAY ADORATION?

Invitation: When Jesus was praying in the garden shortly before He was arrested, He invited His disciples to pray with Him. Upon finding them asleep, He said to them "So you could not keep watch with me for one hour?" (Matthew 26:40) We invite you and your family to spend some time in Adoration before Iesus in the Blessed

Sacrament. Explanation: Adoration is a time when the consecrated host, Jesus Himself, is placed in the monstrance on the altar for us to adore during a quiet time of prayer and reflection. There are many different ways to spend this time – bring a Bible and pray through Scripture, bring your favorite book of prayers or devotions, if you are involved in Walking with Purpose, bring your study book and do your readings in front of the Eucharist, pray a Rosary, or you can simply sit in Jesus' presence and listen to what He wants to say to you. If you have children, have them bring a little bag of books they might find interesting to look at, such as lives of the Saints or simple prayer books.

Sign up for November 3: a sign-up sheet will be available in the weekly Flocknote or on a clipboard in the Gathering Space. People typically sign up for 1 hour, but ALL ARE WELCOME any time! If your time has ended and you are the only one in Church, it is important to remain in Church until the next person arrives, because Jesus should never be left alone during Adoration. Blessed Carlo Acutis (whose Feast Day we just celebrated on October 12) said "By being in the presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, we become holy." Isn't growing in holiness what we are all striving to do? If you have any questions, or if you never attended Adoration and would like to know more about it, please contact Bonnie Creeger at bcreeger@stsimonjude.com.
