> Lenten Message from the Pastor 3rd Sunday of Lent Fr. Dwayne McNew



Dear parish family,

Where do we go to meet God? In college I enjoyed my anthropology classes as we studied cultures and human behavior. Every culture has built Temples, shrines, or churches where people can go to meet God and obtain God's favor. I enjoyed studying the Aztec culture, but I am also grateful that we don't sacrifice human beings as they did or even animals as did the Jews during the time of Christ.

I know some people like to meet God while sitting by a lake or the ocean, walking through a forest, or even visiting the grave of a loved one with flowers in hand.

There was nothing more sacred to the Jewish people of Jesus' time than the Temple in Jerusalem where they kept the Scriptures and the Ark of the Covenant. God's presence dwelt in the Temple, making it the only legitimate place of worship in Israel. In our readings today, Jesus establishes Himself as the New Temple. God has made Jesus the Temple of God's presence.

The Temple in Jerusalem was a foreshadowing of the True Temple, which is the Body of Christ. As Catholics, we believe that Jesus is present in the Eucharist, and that every time we participate in Mass, we are entering into the presence of God.

We pray: Lord as I worship in Your holy place, help me to believe in Your real presence in the Eucharist. You are Lord and God! Amen.
