

RITA MYERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP


The Rita Myers Memorial Scholarship will this year award one (1) scholarship of \$500 to a qualifying high school student towards the cost of tuition at a Catholic High School for the 2024-2025 Academic Year.

The Rita Myers Memorial Scholarship was founded by Mike and Robin Myers jointly with the Knights of Columbus Father Sheldon Kelly Council #11224 as a tribute to Mike's mother, Rita Myers, who was a parishioner at Sts. Simon and Jude for several years.

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:


- a) Be a practicing Catholic and active parishioner at Sts. Simon and Jude;
- b) Planning to attend a Catholic High School for the 2024-2025 Academic Year;
- c) Show a demonstrated commitment to volunteering, including at the parish; and
- d) Complete and submit the attached application.

Scholarship Applications are due by June 2nd, 2024 and can be mailed or dropped off at the Parish Office (mark as Attn: Knights of Columbus). Scholarship will be paid in the form of a check directly to the high school the successful applicant is attending.
